1. Royston Rogers was welcomed to the meeting.
2. The minutes of the last meeting were read and accepted.

3. Matters Arising

a) The Quarry.

RR told the meeting that 'holes' (quarries) were considered valuable assets. KB said that access to the quarry seemed to be the biggest problem. RB told the meeting that it would now go to Committee, probably in July. Anyone who wishes to speak needs to register. Speakers should be well prepared with information about any protected species on the site, photographs (as often one picture can be worth 1000 words). RR suggested a power point presentation would be effective. It would also be a good idea to email photos to the planning members. DJ will take photos and liaise with LB to send them out.

RR said that as a leading member of the Highways Department he would help as much as he could.

4. Working Group Updates

DJ is making a pamphlet on the forthcoming walk. We do not need insurance as long as it is not advertised in the local paper (maybe we should put a disclaimer in the leaflet). He reported on the walls down Thurstonland Bank Road and the diverted footpath at Bank End. If there are any objections to it the public should let the council know.

Our Community, Our Environment

RB needed some details to take to his meeting on Thurs 5th June re the village notice board.

There was a report about Gerry Denton's visit when a group, including Jo Martin, Headteacher at Thurstonland, walked along Marsh Hall Lane, Town Moor and Thurstonland Bank with a view to discussing the lack of pavements there.

MM told us about an entry in Saturday's Daily Examiner about the TVA. She thought it would be a good idea to put in an entry from time to time. She also said she had been approached about the problem of dog mess in the village. RR told us about an experiment that Holme Valley North are trying out in Brockholes where they supply scented bags.

Social Events and Fund Raising

EL reported back about her meeting with the Gala Committee. If we do our share of the work we would be entitled to a share next year. We will do the Tombola at the Gala and take 50% for TVA expenses and give 50% to the Gala. She arranged a meeting with representatives from village

groups. The outcome was that they prefer to do their own fund raising but would consider 3 joint fund raisers a year ...Spring...Summer(Gala)...Autumn/Winter. Co-ordination has to be the key. The Gala is already very much a village event and EL says she will join the Gala Committee next year. There was a discussion on integrating the TVA into the village.

Finance

Our funds now total £13.00. There are several options for application for small grants: Parish (small grants in October), Yorkshire Bank, HSBC, and Yorkshire Building Society. SK took the funding leaflet and said she would look at the lottery site too.
